experiences including music, live street acts, workshops, interactive hot spots, visual arts and speed on two wheels that will captivate and provide something for everyone.

Expect to see more entertainment lighting up the city of Sillamäe, delicious food and drink to tantalize your taste buds, activities to warm up the heart rate, music to liven the soul and lightning speed on two wheels that will

Tour Description

Would you like to experience something special, then come with us on a tour of discovery. There are countless opportunities for tours. On two wheels over hill and dale. Beautiful cycling and mountainbike tours run past green pastures surrounded by breathtaking scenery. Every type of cyclist is catered for. The cycle paths lead over gently rolling hills to beautifully situated towns and villages, past castles and palaces. There is so much to discover in Sillamäe cycling region that one ride is often not enough.

There are plenty of opportunities to relax along the route: Toila spa, Narva-Jõesuu spa invite you to linger. Our cycle routes allow cyclists to get to know everything that IdaViru County is known for. The ride takes you through a number of small towns and villages, with historical buildings and museums waiting for culture lovers, as well as baths and spas for those seeking relaxation. For years, it has been the most popular cycling route in Ida-Viru County, with the reasons for its notoriety being aplenty: the slopes are characterized by only a few ascents, imposing village centers and numerous opportunities for a break.

Fascinating landscapes and small cities form an exciting mixture of natural and cultural highlights. And all of this sits on a perfectly developed bike path. We have deliberately chosen the length of the individual stages shorter so that you have enough time to get off your bike here and there and explore the highlights along the route. Because it is precisely these that make the cycle path so special. The further north you cycle, the more you notice the unmistakable Baltic Sea scent.

Our Cycle Path is also very suitable for beginners, less ambitious cyclists or families with children thanks to the flat route. Soaking up the natural landscape, exploring the area on the bike, experiencing the sights and local culture, taking advantage of rest stops and photo opportunities and covering a whole load of mileage in the meantime. Various cycle paths graded easy to moderate criss-cross the region and invite you to savour the beauties of the landscape and localities.

Alongside a number of ascents and descents, this tour offers breathtaking insights into and outlooks over the local landscape. We cycle through idyllic landscapes via Toila and Narva-Jõesuu. From here we enter a romantic Toila Park, a special natural monument. Every pasture affords spectacular views across the region. Several inns are located right alongside these pastures and invite passers-by to stay a while and enjoy the natural landscape to the full. Your tour guide will tell you about the culture and history of the region.

If you want to discover more, we recommend additional night before or after your cycling tour.
